HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (DISCUSS IMPORTANT PERSONS AND EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS STRUCTURE):
According to Mildred Cook Brown, this house has been associated with the Cook family for many years. Prior to 1961, the house was addressed 256 N. Curtice Ave. The house does not appear on the 1914 Sanborn map, although the County Assessor gives a 1913 date of construction for the dwelling. It does appear on the 1921 map, when it had a full-width open porch. The porch was enclosed between then and the 1932 map. The 1920 U.S. Census indicates that this was the home of Harley and Esther Cook and their children George and Mildred. Mr. Cook was as a mechanic at a garage. In the 1932 city directory, Mr. Cook was listed as a mechanic for Arapahoe County. The 1939 city directory noted that Mildred Cook worked at Red Comet. Harley Cook was listed as the head of the household at this address through 1961. Mildred Cook Brown is the current owner. She was born in Littleton in 1917 and was chosen Miss Littleton of 1937.
