Wehrly. Wehrly had started a blacksmith shop in 1905 in a building to John and James Hoskin. James R. Hoskin worked in Nevadaville as a blacksmith for the Gend Gold Mine, sharpening hardrock drills and making general repairs. He reached his shop via the Argo Tunnel, riding the electric tram. The family moved to Littleton in 1910 and Mr. Hoskin ran this blacksmith shop with his brother, John. In 1932, the building was vacant.
