

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One-story corner house sited at angle across the lot facing northwest. Rectangular plan with hip roof with composition roofing and widely overhanging eaves. Wide asbestos shingle siding covers walls; concrete foundation. Center front door is recessed and faces concrete stoop. Large red brick wall chimney on north. Tripartite window on south with three casements and one on north with center plate glass flanked by casements; both windows have retractable awnings. Front walk curves up to entrance from south driveway. House sits high on site that slopes down to S. Nevada and W. Crestline. Level front yard has lawn with a few shrubs around edges. Yard on north has lawn and large trees. One car garage attached to rear of house. Driveway in back yard edged by low red sandstone retaining wall. Small utility shed with gabled roof at southeast.
