

This building was addressed as 350 and 352 N. Nevada Ave. The 1959 city directory indicates that Dorthy Gauss lived in 350 (5442) and Charles S. Engle and Edward German lived in 352 (5432). In 1961, 350 (5442) was the home of Robert A. Allen and 352 (5432) was the home of Ted R. Gilmer. In 1965, 5432 was the home of DuWayne C. and Jo Beth Bender. Mr. Bender was a mechanic at the Martin Company. Jay L. and Kay Hall lived at 5442 N. Nevada. Mr. Hall was a deputy sheriff for Arapahoe County.
