


ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One-story modified gabled L plan dwelling with attached one-car garage on the south. Composition roofing; eaves are flush with walls. East gable end wall clad with lap siding and east front wall under porch is red brick. Concrete foundation. Door in south side of front gable section has large oval light. Across front of L is shed roof porch with wrought iron supports on concrete slab floor. Large picture window near front door; other windows are casements. Lot goes all the way through the block to S. Curtice, where there is a sign reading "The Patio-Hair Styling by Eloise." Double-wide concrete driveway on south leads to attached garage. Large spruce tree at north side of front yard. Prior to 1961, this house was addressed as 319 N. Nevada Ave. In 1953 and 1955 city directories, this was listed as the home and residence of Paul T. Blakey, who worked as a realtor. In 1959, F.A. Lidolph was listed as the occupant of the house. In 1961, this was the home of L.H. Fairburn. In 1965, Orin H. and Eloise Rising were renting this house. Mr. Rising was a service station operator.
