


ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One-and-a-half-story front gable roof frame dwelling with rectangular plan; overhanging eaves; composition roofing. Wide lap siding on walls; narrow lap siding on gable face; concrete foundation. Front gable end has paired double-hung sash windows sheltered by awning. Off-center porch with concrete base is entered from south; due to overgrown shrubs nothing can be seen of front door or windows of facade. Paired and single windows on south with wide wood surrounds.
