HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (DISCUSS IMPORTANT PERSONS AND EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS STRUCTURE): The 1920 U.S. Census indicates that this was the home of Fred C. and Lela Duncan. Mr. Duncan was listed as the manager of a picture shop. Lela Duncan was listed as a clerk in the treasurer's office. Living here with the Duncans was Edna Rhea, sister-in-law of Mr. Duncan, who worked as a clerk in the post office. Harold Rhea, Mr. Duncan's brother-in law, and Viola Rhea, a second sister-in-law, also lived here. In 1932, this was the home of Harry E. and Edna Noyes. Mr. Noyés was affiliated with Noyes Hardware Company. In 1939, the house was vacant. In 1953 and 1955 city directories, this address was listed as the home of John H. Eberhardt.
