


ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One-and-a-half-story front gable roofed dwelling with overhanging eaves with eave returns and molding along the face of the gable; composition roofing; brick chimney. Narrow lap siding; concrete foundation. Variegated, decorative shingles in gable face, which has paired double-hung windows with shared lintel. Full-width recessed porch with four Doric columns and two engaged columns; wood porch floor on foundation of rock-faced concrete blocks. Hipped roof, shingled dormer on south with group of three double-hung windows in center. Off-center entrance with deep-set window to right and smaller window to left, both with wood surrounds. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (DISCUSS IMPORTANT PERSONS AND EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS STRUCTURE):

This dwelling is present on the 1914 Sanborn Map, but is absent from the Littleton Water Supply Map of 1912; resulting in an estimated construction date of 1913. The 1920 U.S. Census indicates that the house was owned by Steven Noyes, a hardware merchant originally from Wisconsin. He lived here with his wife, Frances, and three children. In 1932, Mrs. Lodie M. Dodge lived at this address. She was a clerk in the Arapahoe County Treasury Department. Mrs. Dodge was shown as owning the house in the 1939 city directory and continued to live here through at least 1961.

This house is representative of early twentieth century dwelling construction in Littleton, and reflects the Edwardian Vernacular style through its gabled roof with eave returns, decorative shingles and narrow lap siding; prominent porch with classical columns, and double-hung sash windows with architrave surrounds.
