


ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: One-story L-shaped commercial building with flat roof consists of wings projecting west and south; east side of wing projecting to south is taller. Narrow metal coping along roof. Metal chimney on east. Walls clad with rock-faced concrete block below windows and on piers and stucco above windows; concrete foundation. East wall of south projecting wing is slanted concrete block. Off-center entrance in west wall of south wing has glazed door. Overhead garage door in south wall of south wing.
