Geneva Village Senior Citizen Housing complex traces its roots in Littleton to the establishment of the Geneva Home by the International Geneva Association, a fraternal and benevolent organization for men employed in the hotel and restaurant business, in 1927. The property had originally been part of a poultry farm and included 4.5 acres of land with a lake. The Geneva Home cared for the needy, old, sick, and incapacitated members of the Association, including many with tuberculosis. In 1964, architect Eugene Sternberg designed Geneva Village, eight buildings with 28 apartments for elderly hotel retirees and their wives. Denver Caterer Max Hummel was instrumental in helping plan the apartments. In 1975, the City of Littleton purchased the complex and the Littleton Housing Authority manages the facility, providing housing for senior citizens of Littleton. This building, on eastern edge of the complex toward the northern end, contained three one-bedroom units (numbered 14 through 16) and a large recreation room at its southern end.
