


Walls composed of brick, with rock-faced concrete block piers enframing storefronts on west. String course above fourth floor. Concrete foundation. Eastern inset area clad with horizontal siding. Central entrance on west elaborated by awning. Multiple storefronts on west first story with plate glass windows. Upper story windows mimic 1/1-light double-hugn sash and are paired.
