

Colorado EFR Screening Form

- 1. Does the modification increase the height of the tower by more than the greater of:
 - 10%
 - Or, the height of an additional antenna array plus separation of up to 20' from the top of the nearest existing antenna?
- 2. Does the modification of other eligible support structures increase the height (measured from top of existing antenna to the bottom of a proposed new antenna by more than the greater of:
 - 10%
 - 10 feet
- 3. Does the modification of a tower add an appurtenance to the body of the tower that would protrude from the edge of the tower more than 20 feet or more than the width of the tower structure at the level of the appurtenance, whichever is greater?
- 4. Does the modification of other eligible support structures add an appurtenance to the body of the structure that would protrude from the edge of the structure by more than 6 ft?
- 5. Does the modification involve the installation of more than the standard number of new equipment cabinets for the technology involved or add more than four new equipment cabinets?
- 6. Does the modification entail any excavation or deployment outside the current site by more than 30 feet in any direction, not including any access or utility easements?
- 7. Does the modification defeat the concealment elements of the eligible support structure?
- 8. Does the modification violate conditions associated with the siting approval with the prior approval the tower or base station other than as specified in 47 C.F.R. § 1.6100(c)(7)(i) (iv)?
