


HISTORICAL BACKGROUND (DISCUSS IMPORTANT PERSONS AND EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS STRUCTURE): This site is vacant on the 1921 Sanborn fire insurance map but this building is present on the 1932 edition. The 1932 Littleton city directory identifies this building as Bill's Cafe, Bill Page, proprietor. The building is addressed as 337 W. Main St. In 1939, the Littleton Cafe, Mike Mingen, manager, was located here. The 1949 Sanborn indicates that a restaurant was located in the building in that year. The Wagon Wheel Tavern is shown here in city directories and photographs for the 1947 through 1965 period. The Wagon Wheel was owned by William and Mary Schroder. The Sanborn map evidence and the building's tile wall construction do not support an earlier survey's conclusion that this building was the Littleton Garage built in 1907. <div style="text-align: right;">CONTINUED YES X NO</div>

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: This building is associated with the historic commercial development of Littleton, having been erected by 1932 and having housed restaurants and a saloon.
