4 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
5 LITTLETON, COLORADO AMENDING ORDINANCE 16-
6 2022 REGARDING THE TITLE OF THE BALLOT
7 QUESTION RELATED TO THE CREATION OF A
8 DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

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10 WHEREAS, the Littleton City Council approved submission of a ballot question
11 for inclusion on the November 8, 2022 ballot regarding the formation of a Downtown
12 Development Authority (DDA); and

13 WHEREAS, that ballot question included a lengthy legal description and map of
14 the proposed boundaries of the DDA; and

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16 WHEREAS, the same legal description and map is not statutorily required to
17 appear on the ballot; and

18 WHEREAS, a dedicated URL at which a fully executed copy of Ordinance 16-
19 2022, containing the full legal description and map and approved by city council on August 16,
20 2022 may be found will be included in the new ballot language.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
22 OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

23 **Section 1:** Amended ballot question to read as follows:

24 “Shall the Littleton Downtown Development Authority be organized pursuant
25 to Part 8 of Article 25 of Title 31, Colorado Revised Statutes, to exercise all
26 powers authorized therein and in any approved plan of development within the
27 boundaries of the Littleton Downtown Development Authority as described in
28 Ordinance 16-2022 (<https://www.littletongov.org/dda-ordinance>)”

29 **Section 2:** Severability. If any one or more sections or parts of this Ordinance
30 shall be judged unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or
31 invalidate the remaining provisions hereof, it being the intention of the City
32 Council that the various provisions hereof are severable. If any individual tract of
33 land included within the area described in this Ordinance is determined by a court
34 of competent jurisdiction to be excluded from the DDA, should the formation of
35 the DDA be authorized by the qualified electors, such determination shall not
36 affect, impair, or invalidate the inclusion of the remaining area described in this

37 Ordinance in the DDA, it being the intention of the City Council that the inclusion
38 of the separate tracts of land described herein be severable.

39 **Section 3:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict
40 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal
41 the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

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44 INTRODUCED AS AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE and adopted at a regularly
45 scheduled meeting of the city council of the City of Littleton on the 6th day of September, 2022,
46 by a vote of 6 FOR and 0 AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center,
47 Bemis Library, the Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.
