11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, Current City Code and Charter requires for each day that library material(s) are not returned past such library materials' due date, there is a per item, per day late charge to be established by the library according to material type; and
16 17 18 19	<b>WHEREAS</b> , Bemis Public Library wants to eliminate overdue fines and eliminate a barrier to library use to make the library a more inclusive and welcoming place, by increasing access to the library for people who benefit from library resources the most; and
20 21 22	<b>WHEREAS</b> , The majority of libraries in the Denver metro area have eliminated overdue fines and report an increase in circulation, an increase in items returned, and an increase in new library cardholders; and
23 24	WHEREAS, The cost to collect overdue fines is greater than the amount of fines collected.
25 26 27 28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:
29 30 31	<b>Section 1:</b> Littleton City Code Title 6 Chapter 9 Section 6 (B) 5 pertaining to library overdue fines is hereby repealed.
32 33 34 35 36 37 38	<b>Section 2:</b> Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The city council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared invalid.
39 40 41 42	<b>Section 3:</b> Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.
