7 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLETON,
8 COLORADO, AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
9 OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, STORMWATER AND
10 FLOOD MANAGEMENT UTILITY ENTERPRISE,
11 AMENDING THE 2023 LITTLETON STORMWATER AND
12 FLOOD MANAGEMENT UTILITY ENTERPRISE BUDGET

14 WHEREAS, the city council established the City of Littleton, Colorado,
15 Stormwater and Flood Management Utility Enterprise (the “Enterprise”) by Ordinance No. 33,
16 Series of 2013; and

18 WHEREAS, the city council, as the governing body of the Enterprise, has the
19 authority under said ordinance to establish the budget for the Enterprise; and

20
21 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 25, Series of 2022 established the budgeted
22 expenditures for the City of Littleton, Colorado, Stormwater and Flood Management Utility
23 Enterprise; and

25 WHEREAS, the necessity of receiving and expending additional monies from the
26 Enterprise could not have been reasonably anticipated during the time of the adoption of the budget
27 and appropriation of funds in accordance therewith.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
30 THE CITY OF LITTLETON, COLORADO, THAT:

32 Section 1: The budgeted expenditures for the City of Littleton, Colorado,
33 Stormwater and Flood Management Utility Enterprise for the period of January 1, 2023 to
34 December 31, 2023 are hereby amended by the following addition:

40 Section 2: The total budgeted expenditures for the City of Littleton, Colorado,
41 Stormwater and Flood Management Utility Enterprise for the period of January 1, 2023 to
42 December 31, 2023 shall be amended to \$3,230,608.

44 Section 3: Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or
45 phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the

46 validity of the remaining sections of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would
47 have passed this ordinance, including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase
48 hereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or
49 phrases may be declared invalid.

51 **Section 4:** Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict
52 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that this repealer shall not repeal the repealer
53 clauses of such ordinance nor revive any ordinance thereby.

56 INTRODUCED AS A BILL at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council

57 of the City of Littleton on the 7th day of March, 2023, passed on first reading by a vote of _ FOR

58 and _ AGAINST; and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center, Bemis Library, the

59 Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.

60 PUBLIC HEARING on the Ordinance to take place on the 21st day of March, 2023,

61 in the Council Chamber, Littleton Center, 2255 West Berry Avenue, Littleton, Colorado, at the

62 hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard.

64 PASSED on second and final reading, following public hearing, by a vote of _ FOR and _

65 AGAINST on the 21st day of March, 2023 and ordered published by posting at Littleton Center,

66 Bemis Library, the Municipal Courthouse and on the City of Littleton Website.
